AVA/2020/0994. 129 Peasehill, Ripley, Derbyshire, DE5 3JN. Residential development consisting of up to 17 dwellings including details of access to be considered. Major Dwellings 10 or more.

RESOLVED that Ripley Town Council object to this proposal for the following reasons;

- This land is close to an area in which archaeological remains have been found, and should be the subject of archaeological field evaluation (in line with NPPF para 199).
- As the site falls within the defined Development High Risk Area, a Coal Mining Risk Assessment should be completed, particularly due to the records of the Coal Authority, which shows that the site lies in an area of likely historic unrecorded coal workings at a shallow depth.
- There needs to be further details on the disposal of surface water from the site.
- There are environmental concerns for the site, including the effect on wildlife, nesting of birds, bats and owls.
- Highways access/egress to site not suitable, due to parked cars reducing visibility on Peashill.
